### Share an eternal bond

Jaclyn Smith got choked up recently when she read a special letter from her former *Charlie's Angels* co-star and friend, the late Farrah Fawcett. "Fear of everything seems around the corner every day, and it's my biggest test, because I was never bothered by fear," Jaclyn, on Katie Couric's talk show, read from the letter Farrah sent months before her June 2009 death from anal cancer at age 62. "I always felt that if I succeeded, that was great, and if something failed, my attitude was: 'What's the

worst that could happen?' A failure. So you just move on. But this fear doesn't work that way." Farrah signed off one of the last letters she ever wrote by thanking her friend. Jaclyn, who got teary while reading the emotional message, marveled at how strong Farrah remained until the very end of her three-year fight to live. "Every single day she was faced with what was ahead of her, but not giving up," Jaclyn, 68, told Katie. "But she got something that she just couldn't whip. She tried her best."
